Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.33 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 15, down 4 percent from the week prior and 4 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 15, was 3.80 million, down 16 percent from the previous week, but up 13 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 15, down 2 percent from the week prior, but up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 15, was 13.9 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 2 percent from the previous year.
