Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.65 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 29, up 3 percent from the week prior, but slightly below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 29, down 2 percent from the week prior, but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 29, was 4.23 million, up 12 percent from the previous week and up 12 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 29, was 14.2 million, down 2 percent from the previous week, but up 4 percent from the previous year.
