**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.65 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 31, down slightly from the week prior, but 2 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 17.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 31, up slightly from the week prior and up 26 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 31, was 5.62 million, up 22 percent from the previous week and up 44 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 31, was 14.5 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 11 percent from the previous year.
