Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.66 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 14, down 14 percent from the week prior and 11 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 16.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 14, up 3 percent from the week prior and up 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 14, was 5.03 million, up 28 percent from the previous week and up 57 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 14, was 14.2 million, down 2 percent from the previous week but up 9 percent from the previous year.
