Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.39 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 21, up 11 percent from the week prior, but 1 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 21, up 4 percent from the week prior and up 13 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 21, was 5.06 million, down 8 percent from the previous week and down 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 21, was 13.9 million, down 2 percent from the previous week, but up 22 percent from the previous year.
