Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.78 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 26, up 21 percent from the week prior and 29 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 26, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 26, was 3.87 million, up 39 percent from the previous week and up 15 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 26, was 13.5 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 10 percent from the previous year.
