Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.88 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 14, up 9 percent from the week prior and 8 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 14, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 28 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 14, was 4.28 million, down 3 percent from the previous week, but up 10 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 14, was 14.2 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 9 percent from the previous year.
