

The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of March. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas operators are the foundation of the estimates for the Southern Plains region. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. We would like to thank all operators who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available on June 28, 2019.

**Oklahoma** stocks of wheat in all positions on March 1 totaled 101 million bushels, were down 18 percent from the 2018 level of 123 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 98.5 million bushels, were 18 percent lower than March 1, 2018.


**Texas** stocks of wheat in all positions on March 1, at 89.5 million bushels, were up 4 percent from the 2018 level of 86.1 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 87.6 million bushels, were 3 percent higher than March 1, 2018.

All Positions




**Texas** off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 28.3 million bushels. On-farm stocks for sorghum totaled 1.00 million bushels on March 1, 2019. **Texas** off-farm corn stocks, at 76.4 million bushels, were down 7 percent from last year. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.

**Oklahoma** off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 4.21 million bushels, down 23 percent March 1, 2018. On-farm stocks for sorghum are not published for the state. **Oklahoma** off-farm corn stocks, at 10.3 million bushels, were down 11 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.

**U.S. Highlights:** Total stocks of corn in the United States on March 1, 2019 were 8.60 billion bushels, 3 percent lower than March 1, 2018. All wheat stocks were estimated at 1.59 billion bushels in all positions, up 6 percent from last March. U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 193 million bushels, 37 percent above March 1, 2018. Stocks of soybeans in all positions totaled 2.72 billion bushels, up 29 percent from last year.
