


This report contains the results of the October Citrus Survey. The Southern Plains Regional Field Office would like to thank all growers that responded to the Citrus Survey.

The October 1, 2019, Texas **grapefruit production** is forecast at 5.70 million boxes for the 2019-2020 season, down 7 percent from last year's final production of 6.10 million boxes. All **orange production** is estimated at 2.70 million boxes, up 8 percent from last year's final production of 2.50 million boxes. Early and midseason oranges account for 2.05 million boxes and Valencias account for 650 thousand boxes.

**U.S. Highlights:** United States grapefruit production is forecast at 14.5 million boxes, up 5 percent from last year's final. All orange production is forecast at 124 million boxes, down slightly from last year's final.
