Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.69 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 14, up 5 percent from the week prior but 2 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 14, up 3 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 14, was 5.16 million, up 27 percent from the previous week and up 45 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 14, was 14.1 million, up 7 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
