Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.52 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 11, down 8 percent from the week prior and 16 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 11, down 6 percent from the week prior and down 14 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 11, was 3.33 million, down 22 percent from the previous week and down 27 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 11, was 12.7 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 9 percent from the previous year.
