Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.01 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 30, down 6 percent from the week prior and 9 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 30, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 30, was 3.76 million, up 10 percent from the previous week, but down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 30, was 14.5 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
