Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.38 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 6, up 5 percent from the week prior, but 4 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 6, down slightly from the week prior, but up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 6, was 3.26 million, down 13 percent from the previous week and down 28 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 6, was 14.4 million, down slightly from the previous week, but up 2 percent from the previous year.
