Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.44 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 20, down 7 percent from the week prior and 13 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 20, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 20, was 3.45 million, down 21 percent from the previous week and down 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 20, was 14.8 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
