Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.17 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 11, up 11 percent from the week prior but 5 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 11, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 11, was 5.40 million, up 15 percent from the previous week and up 25 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 11, was 15.8 million, up 7 percent from the previous week and up 9 percent from the previous year.
