Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.86 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 25, down slightly from the week prior and 5 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 25, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 25, was 3.91 million, up 17 percent from the previous week, but down 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 25, was 14.2 million, down 4 percent from the previous week and down 3 percent from the previous year.
