Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.90 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 22, down 3 percent from the week prior and 10 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 22, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 22, was 4.44 million, up 56 percent from the previous week, but down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 22, was 14.3 million, up 3 percent from the previous week, but down 2 percent from the previous year.
