Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.52 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 19, down 11 percent from the week prior and 12 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 16.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 19, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 19, was 4.34 million, down 11 percent from the previous week and down 12 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 19, was 13.9 million, down 4 percent from the previous week and down slightly from the previous year.
