Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.80 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 19, down 1 percent from the week prior and 14 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 19, down slightly from the week prior, but up slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 19, was 3.27 million, down 24 percent from the previous week and down 24 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 19, was 14.8 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 4 percent from the previous year.
