



The January 1, 2020, Texas **grapefruit production** is forecast at 6.20 million boxes for the 2019-2020 season, up 2 percent from last year's final production of 6.10 million boxes. All **orange production** is estimated at 2.56 million boxes, up 2 percent from last year's final production of 2.50 million boxes. Early and midseason oranges account for 1.95 million boxes and Valencias account for 610 thousand boxes.

U.S. Highlights: United States grapefruit production is forecast at 15.7 million boxes, up 14 percent from last year's final. All orange production is forecast at 126 million boxes, up 1 percent from last year's final.
