Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.16 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 17, up 1 percent from the week prior, but down 5 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 17, down slightly from the week prior and down 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 17, was 3.21 million, down 25 percent from the previous week and down 26 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 17, was 14.7 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and up slightly from the previous year.
