Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.07 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 23, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 7 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 23, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 23, was 3.74 million, up 17 percent from the previous week, but down 11 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 23, was 14.6 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and from the previous year.
