Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.32 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 6, up 5 percent from the week prior but 4 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 6, down 4 percent from the week prior and down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 6, was 3.87 million, up 8 percent from the previous week and up 11 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 6, was 14.7 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and slightly down from the previous year.
