Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.17 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 13, down 2 percent from the week prior and 6 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 13, was 4.71 million, up 9 percent from the previous week and up 35 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 13, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 13, was 14.0 million, down 4 percent from the previous week and down 5 percent from the previous year.
