Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.16 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 6, down 5 percent from the week prior and down 6 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 6, down 9 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 6, was 2.62 million, down 40 percent from the previous week and down 25 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 6, was 14.0 million, down 6 percent from the previous week and down 5 percent from the previous year.
