Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.54 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 17, down slightly from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 17, was 4.46 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and up 28 percent from the previous year.
