Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.63 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 24, up 1 percent from the week prior and slightly above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 24, was 4.04 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and up 16 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 24, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 24, was 14.7 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and up slightly from the previous year.
