**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.98 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 22, down 1 percent from the week prior but 5 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 22, was 3.87 million, up 3 percent from the previous week and up 11 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 18.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 22, down 1 percent from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 22, was 15.0 million, down 2 percent from the previous week but up 2 percent from the previous year.
