Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.94 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 5, up 1 percent from the week prior and 4 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 5, was 4.82 million, down 2 percent from the previous week but up 39 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 18.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 5, up slightly from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 5, was 15.1 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 3 percent from the previous year.
