Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.64 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 26, up 1 percent from the week prior and 1 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 26, was 3.53 million, down 3 percent from the previous week and up 1 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 26, down slightly from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous vear.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 26, was 14.7 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and up slightly from the previous year.
