Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.62 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 24, down 1 percent from the week prior but up slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 24, was 4.30 million, up 14 percent from the previous week and up 24 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 18.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 24, up 4 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous vear.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 24, was 14.2 million, down slightly from the previous week and down 3 percent from the previous year.
