Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.97 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 28, down 6 percent from the week prior and down 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 28, was 3.76 million, down 17 percent from the previous week, but up 8 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 28, down 5 percent from the week prior and down 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 28, was 13.9 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 6 percent from the previous year.
