Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.34 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 18, up 12 percent from the week prior, but down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 18, was 3.97 million, down 11 percent from the previous week, but up 14 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 18, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 18, was 13.9 million, down 3 percent from the previous week and down 5 percent from the previous year.
