Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.70 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 25, up 5 percent from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 25, was 3.68 million, down 17 percent from the previous week, but up 6 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 17.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 25, up 6 percent from the week prior, but down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 25, was 13.7 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and down 7 percent from the previous year.
