Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.17 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 9, up 1 percent from the week prior, but down 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 9, was 4.36 million, up 20 percent from the previous week and up 25 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 16.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 9, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 9, was 12.8 million, down 11 percent from the previous week and down 13 percent from the previous year.
