Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.73 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 23, up 6 percent from the week prior and 2 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 23, was 3.48 million, down 8 percent from the previous week and down slightly from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 23, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 23, was 13.6 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and down 8 percent from the previous year.
