Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.79 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 6, down 10 percent from the week prior and 11 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 6, was 5.26 million, up 48 percent from the previous week and up 51 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 6, down 5 percent from the week prior and from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 6, was 13.6 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and down 7 percent from the previous year.
