Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.39 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 27, down 4 percent from the week prior and down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 27, was 4.68 million, down slightly from the previous week, but up 35 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 18.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 27, up slightly from the week prior and up 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 27, was 13.7 million, down 11 percent from the previous week and down 7 percent from the previous year.
