

This report contains results from the September 2021 Cattle on Feed Survey collected during the first two weeks of September. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next monthly survey will be made available on October 22, 2021.

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in **Texas** feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 2.70 million head on September 1, 2021, down 5 percent from a year ago. Producers placed 395 thousand head in commercial feedlots during August, down 10 percent from a year ago. Texas commercial feeders marketed 400 thousand head during August, down 7 percent from 2020.

On September 1, there were 2.40 million head of cattle and calves on feed in the Northern High Plains, 89 percent of the state's total. The number on feed across the area was down 5 percent from last year and down 1 percent from the August 1 total. August placements in the Northern High Plains totaled 359 thousand head, up 7 percent from the July total. Marketings were down 3 percent from last month at 358 thousand head.





Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in **Oklahoma** feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 275 thousand head on September 1, 2021, down 11 percent from a year ago. Producers placed 57 thousand head in commercial feedlots during August, down 2 percent from a year ago. Oklahoma commercial feeders marketed 51 thousand head during August, down 2 percent from 2020. Other disappearance during August totaled 1 thousand head, unchanged from a year ago.
