

The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of June. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas operators are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. We would like to thank all operators who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available on September 30, 2021.

**Oklahoma** stocks of wheat in all positions on June 1 totaled 69.7 million bushels, up 11 percent from the 2020 level of 63.0 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 68.5 million bushels, were 11 percent higher than June 1, 2020.


**Texas** stocks of wheat in all positions on June 1, at 57.4 million bushels, were down 11 percent from the 2020 level of 64.5 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 56.1 million bushels, were 11 percent lower than June 1, 2020.

## Quarterly Wheat Stocks All Positions




**Texas** off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 10.3 million bushels. On-farm stocks for sorghum totaled 100 thousand bushels on June 1, 2021.

**Texas** off-farm corn stocks, at 44.0 million bushels, were down 21 percent from last year. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.



**Oklahoma** off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 981 thousand bushels, down 46 percent June 1, 2020. On-farm stocks for sorghum are not published for the state.

**Oklahoma** off-farm corn stocks, at 4.00 million bushels, were down 8 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.

**U.S. Highlights:** Total stocks of corn in the United States on June 1, 2021 were 4.11 billion bushels, 18 percent lower than June 1, 2020. All wheat stocks were estimated at 844 million bushels in all positions, down 18 percent from last June. U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 40.8 million bushels, 44 percent below June 1, 2020. Stocks of soybeans in all positions totaled 767 million bushels, down 44 percent from last year.
