**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 8.07 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 27, down slightly from the week prior but up 16 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 27, was 3.79 million, down 19 percent from the previous week but up 1 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 19.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 27, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 11 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 27, was 15.4 million, up 5 percent from the previous week and up 11 percent from the previous year.
