Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.79 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 17, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 17, was 4.30 million, down 18 percent from the previous week, but up 8 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 17, up slightly from the week prior and up 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 17, was 15.3 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and up 10 percent from the previous year.
