Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.38 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 8, down 3 percent from the week prior but slightly up from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 8, was 4.76 million, down slightly from the previous week but up 5 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 17.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 8, down 6 percent from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 8, was 14.4 million, down 5 percent from the previous week but up 12 percent from the previous year.
