Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.73 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 19, up 5 percent from the week prior and up slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 19, was 4.40 million, down 7 percent from the previous week and down 9 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 19, down slightly from the week prior and down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 19, was 15.3 million, up 8 percent from the previous week but down 1 percent from the previous year.
