Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.70 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 10, up 5 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 10, was 4.10 million, down 14 percent from the previous week but up 11 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 18.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 10, up 1 percent from the week prior and down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 10, was 14.5 million, up 2 percent from the previous week but down 2 percent from the previous year.
