Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.64 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 20, up 2 percent from the week prior but down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 20, was 5.22 million, up 10 percent from the previous week and up 65 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 20, down 1 percent from the week prior and down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 20, was 14.8 million, up 3 percent from the previous week but down 6 percent from the previous year.
