Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.44 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 27, down 3 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 27, was 4.09 million, down 22 percent from the previous week and down 14 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 18.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 27, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 27, was 14.9 million, up slightly from the previous week but down 1 percent from the previous year.
