Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.43 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 17, down 5 percent from the week prior and down 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 17, was 4.12 million, down 23 percent from the previous week and down 25 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 17, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 17, was 15.1 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
