Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.34 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 12, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 12, was 3.91 million, down 11 percent from the previous week and down 15 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 12, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 12, was 14.9 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 3 percent from the previous year.
