Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.71 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 18, down slightly from the week prior and down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 18, was 3.37 million, down 21 percent from the previous week and down 15 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 18.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 18, up 1 percent from the week prior and up slightly from the previous vear.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 18, was 14.7 million, up 7 percent from the previous week but down 4 percent from the previous year.
